If it sounds too good to be true, it probably is!

If it's too good to be true it probably is!

Have you ever received an email that sounds just too good to be true? Maybe it's half price on a name brand pair of shoes, a coupon for a free night stay in a fancy hotel, or letting you know you just won a free cruise to the Bahamas! You just have to [click the link](#) on the email and all will be yours! Unfortunately, these offers are not as perfect as they appear. Fraudsters are crafty in their emails and often appear to be legitimate businesses or even a company that you've worked with before. The fake websites are replicated down to the finest of details making it extremely difficult to decipher the fraudulent from the legitimate. According to [Stats Canada](#), out of 156 million scam emails sent out each day, 8 million of them are opened.

Tips to determine if the email is a scam

Pay extra attention to those emails that appear to good to be true. Have you ever heard of this company or person before? Be suspicious if the name seems unfamiliar and you don't recall ever signing up to the company or sharing details with this individual before. Also, avoid any emails that involve inputting your personal and/or financial details. Emails with bad spelling and/or poor grammar is another easy way to spot a scam, but don't forget to check the URL of the link provided for spelling mistakes as well.

So you clicked the link, tips to determine if the website is a scam

So you clicked the link on the email, now what? Although the website you're directed to can appear legitimate, there are ways to check it's validity. Does the website have an option to read up on the company's Terms & Conditions, Privacy Clause, Return Policy, and Legal Conditions? If they do, do the terms include spelling mistakes or vague statements? [When in doubt](#), perform a web search of the company online and check their official website compared to the one you had opened through the email and check for differences such as the company logo, graphic quality, and verbiage.

Trust your intuition - if it sounds too good to be true, it probably is!
