Don't be Robbed of Your Holiday Vacation!

As the holiday's fast approach, many of us begin to gear up for the festivities and take advantage of the time off to visit family and friends all over the country, and for some, the world. With the travel season in full effect, scammers increase their fraudulent email travel offers. This means scrolling through an overwhelming amount of travel deals flooding your inbox trying to figure out the real from the bogus.

How it works...

The Scam: you receive an email containing an amazing offer for an exceptional and hard to refuse destination or accommodation that expires in a short period of time. These emails are linked to fraudulent websites that trick people into thinking they're reserving directly with their hotel or travel company of choice. Instead, the victims are making reservations on phony sites set up to steal your money, credit card information, and holiday vacation.

How to Protect Yourself

When you are purchasing your flight or hotel, make sure you purchase them through a reputable source. If you do plan on booking a flight or hotel through a third-party website, be sure to do your due diligence. Look for accreditation's on the website from IATA (International Air Transport Association) or other travel associations to ensure they have been vetted appropriately. Double check the spelling in the email as well as the URL of the website. If you are unsure, call the company before you book and check that the deal and the website is legitimate.
